Competition formula:

Epée Ladies and Men, individual FIE satellite: two rounds of pools followed by direct elimination. Position in the table of the direct elimination will be defined by the results of the 2nd round of pool only. The bronze medal will not be fenced.

Epée Veterans, Ladies and Men, individual: one round of pool followed by direct elimination of 10 points. The categories will be fenced separately if there are at least 3 participants per category. The bronze medal will not be fenced.

Please note: the age difference (by the dates of birth) of more than 10 years between the fencers will be compensated in favor of the older person: the younger fencer will have one negative point (-1) in the start of the match. In case of age difference of more than 20 years, the compensation will be -2 points. This is applicable also in direct elimination and in the start of the eventual second set.

Epée Men, team competition: 3+1 fencers. One round of pool followed by direct elimination. The ranking is defined by the results of the individual FIE satellite competition of the 16th October 2010. At least 2 fencers of the team must represent the same club. No female fencers. Please confirm the names of the team fencers at the latest on Saturday 16th October at 16h00 in the competition office. The bronze medal will not be fenced.

Registration:

Epée Ladies and Men, individual FIE Satellite: Each fencer must have the valid FIE licence. Each licence must be registered officially in the FIE system and visible at the FIE website (www.fie.ch) by the 4th October 2010 at the latest.

Inscription:

Epée Ladies and Men, individual, FIE Satellite: last date for the registration is the **6th October 2010** through the national federation and via the FIE system www.fie.ch.

Epée Veterans Ladies and Men, individual and Epée Men team competition: last date for the registration is the **8th October 2010** to the secretary of the Turku Fencing Club:

Inscription fees:

Epée Ladies and Men, individual:	20 euros per person
Epée Veterans, Ladies and Men, individual:	10 euros per person
Epée Men, team competition:	20 euros per team

All the payments by Clubs at site in euros only.

Rules:

According to the general FIE rules. **The FIE blades are obligatory in the individual FIE Satellite competitions.** Obligatory identification: the name and country of the fencer must be indicated on the back of the jacket and the country flag on the trousers.

Referees:

Important, please note: According to the general FIE rules (art. o.81): every country with more than 4 fencers per category must present at least one referee, and with more than 9 fencers per category at least two referees.

For A Grade or candidate A Grade competitions, should a national federation not bring the required number of referees, it will be charged a **fine of 500 Euros/750 Swiss francs if the organiser was informed 15 days before the competition, or of 1000 Euros/1500 Swiss francs if the organiser was not informed 15 days before the competition.**

This fine must be paid by the delegation to the organisers, who may keep this amount provided that they ensure the services of the referee(s) necessary to replace the missing referee(s). This fine reverts to the FIE if the organisers do not arrange the presence of replacement international referees, who may be from the organising country. Under whatever circumstances, if a national federation does not pay this fine, it must reduce the participation of its fencers in conformity with the quotas.
